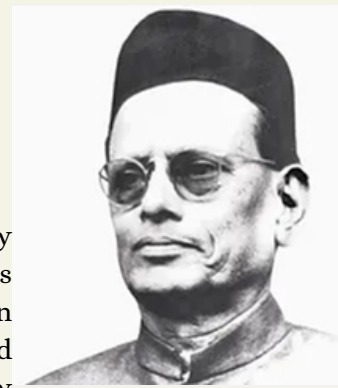

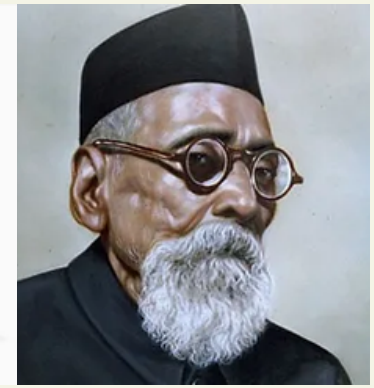
KInSS Legacy

MSW Program and Specializations

The Institute offers four specialization courses for the Master in Social Work Programme: Family and Child Welfare, Medical and Psychiatric Social Work, Human Resources Management, and Urban and Rural Community Development. To bring uniformity in standards and status at par with other National and International Universities, Pune University has adopted the semester and credit pattern since June 2008. It has reviewed and changed the MSW curricula substantially. The Institute has played a significant role in developing curricula that address the emerging challenges and needs of diverse social realities. Some of the fieldwork components, such as orientation visits, advanced orientation visits, rural camps and study tours, have been given weightage in the fieldwork component and are the regular components of the new curriculum.

- Family and Child Welfare
- Human Resource Management
- Medical and Psychiatric Social Work
- Urban and Rural Community Development

Family and Child Welfare

This specialization which focuses on all aspects of the family, qualifies graduates to work as Social Workers in institutions for women and children, Supervisors of the Integrated Child Development Scheme, as Family Counsellors in Family Courts, as Counsellors in schools and in a variety of research and development programmes. The trainees will have to work with individuals and families in crises, with children with emotional, adjustment and behavioural problems and with people with special needs.



Human Resource Management

This specialization is concerned with the human resources and the dynamic situations in industry. It is an essential qualification for the post of Labour Welfare Officers under the Factories Act, 1948. The specialization equips the graduates to work as Personnel Officers and HR Executives in the Public / Private /Service sector. Students will be placed in industrial organizations for fieldwork during the Second Year of training.



Medical and Psychiatric Social Work

This is an essential qualification for employment as Medical and Psychiatric Social Workers in General Hospitals and medical settings. Students are placed for fieldwork in general hospitals, mental hospitals, child guidance clinics, de-addiction centres and social welfare departments of industries. Only those persons with an aptitude to work with the sick and willing to acquire knowledge of various physical and mental health problems may opt for this specialization.



Urban and Rural Community Development

This specialization equips social work graduates to work as Community Organisers, Supervisors and Project Officers in community based organisations working with the underprivileged groups in rural and urban areas. Students will be placed in both urban and rural settings for fieldwork during the second year of training. They will be expected to have a high level of motivation and develop skills to draw peoples' participation in community work carried out by Government and Non-Government organisations.

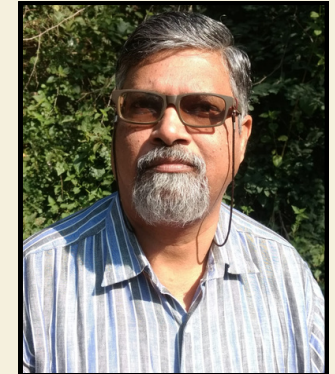

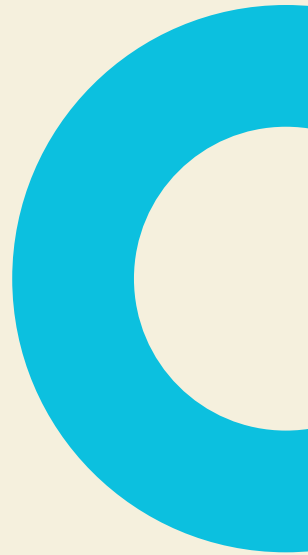

Our Philosophy of Training & Job Placement

- Placement helps the organizations to find the right candidate and they don't have to waste time searching for it outside. These placements create a good bond between the company and the college as the next batch will be ready for getting recruited and the company will also have new open positions for the students.
- As well as allowing students to apply subject knowledge and technical skills in a professional environment, placements also provide a helpful insight into organizational discourse, culture, professional socialisation, applied skills and working relationships.
- To ensure a seamless transition from academic life to the professional world, Karve Institute of Social Service (KISS) has established a dedicated Job Placement Cell (JPC) to support its students in securing employment that aligns with their career goals.
- Every year, the JPC organizes a Campus Recruitment Drive held from December to February, providing graduating students with the opportunity to make informed employment decisions. Representatives from government, non-governmental organizations (NGOs), and private sectors, both local and international, are invited to participate. This comprehensive approach exposes students to a diverse range of social service agencies and the vast career options available upon graduation.
- Through successful campus recruitments, our students have secured placements with NGOs, government, semi-government, and corporate organizations across India, England, and the United States. Organizations interested in participating in our Campus Recruitment Drive are encouraged to contact the Job Placement Officer. It's important to note that there is no registration fee, and recruitment will be conducted entirely online.
- The JPC extends its services beyond graduating students by assisting alumni in their job search. Throughout the year, the JPC actively mails job vacancies to its alumni network. We invite organizations with job openings to contact the Job Placement Officer. This vacancy information will then be disseminated to all alumni members and individuals visiting the JPC for job search assistance.



Recruitment Guidelines

Introduction

To enable a smooth transition from academia to the professional world, the Job Placement Cell (JPC) at Karve Institute of Social Service, Pune assists students in securing job opportunities aligned with their aspirations and competencies. The JPC is dedicated to bridging the gap between social work education and meaningful employment in the Governmental, Non-Governmental, and Private Sectors.

Campus Recruitment Drive

The JPC conducts an Annual Campus Recruitment Drive from January to April to provide final-year students with employment opportunities and career guidance.

The drive facilitates interactions between students and recruiters, enabling them to make informed employment decisions.

Agencies from Government, NGOs, Semi-Government, and the Corporate Sector at local, national, and international levels are invited.

The recruitment process exposes students to diverse career options within the field of social work and CSR.

Job Placement Assistance

- The JPC actively facilitates job placement by:
- Assisting students in drafting resumes and cover letters.
- Conducting mock interviews and career guidance workshops.
- Providing one-on-one career counselling to help students identify the best opportunities.
- Offering insights into sector-specific career paths in social work, mental health, community development, human rights, and corporate social responsibility (CSR).
